"Spiritual Check-Up"

Periodically we head to the doctor for a general checkup. There is no urgent health crisis that has caused us to go. The aim is to talk about how our overall physical health is doing and for the doctor to know how to best care for us.

As your pastor, I have begun going through our membership and scheduling what I am calling "Spiritual Check-Ups." The aim is to listen to you and how things are going in your walk with the Lord so that I can better know how specifically I can encourage, disciple and pray for each member of our church.

As I have begun to have these visits with different church members, no two visits have gone the same. But here are a sampling of the kinds of things we might talk about:

- 1. How would you explain what the gospel is? (I think this is a great thing for Christians to remind one another of, help one another clarify in our minds, and better know how to explain it to an unbeliever).
- 2. Let's share with each other our testimonies of how we became Christians. (I have realized that there are many church members that I don't know this story about their lives, and what better story is there to know!?).
- 3. What is something that the Lord has been teaching you lately?
- 4. What encouraging things are happening in your walk with God?
- 5. What discouraging things are happening in your walk with God?
- 6. What are you doing for your own personal bible study/how is your personal bible study going?
- 7. Who are you trying to evangelize/disciple in your circles of influence? How is that going?
- 8. What ways can I better care for you as your pastor?
- 9. How do you feel you are connected with the life of the body of Christ?
- 10. What ways is the church helping you grow up into Christ? In what ways can the church better help you grow up into Christ?

This list is not exhaustive. I'm sure there will be plenty of other things that we may talk about in these conversations. My aim is to do as much listening (if not more) as I do talking, so that I can better understand the joys and hardships of each member so that I can hopefully more faithfully shepherd individual members and the church as a whole as we follow Christ together.

I look forward to scheduling this time with each of you in the coming weeks/months!
