Prayer in Response to the Word

Matt 7:13-14

Discovery Clubs currently has 164 trained volunteer mentors reaching over 1000 children with the Gospel of Jesus Christ in 19 public elementary schools in Birmingham and the surrounding counties and is adding schools each year.

Today, Discovery Clubs is a ministry of the Birmingham Metro Baptist Association and is supported by many partnering churches from all denominations throughout Birmingham City and the surrounding counties.
